# Tic Tac Toe'Touch

## 2 players, all ages

### Tic Tac Toe'Touch by after-mouse.com Bring your family back together!

Tic Tac Toe'Touch is a fun new take on the traditional childrens game. The game board consists of a 3X3 grid that players mark with X and O in alternating turns. The game is won when one player is able connect 3 of their marks in a row, vertically, horizontally, or diagonally. If neither player is able to connect their 3 marks, the game is a draw.


## **How to Play**

The game begins with a blank game board divided into nine squares. Tic Tac Toe requires two players.

Each player begins the round by selecting the "Start a game" button on both sides of the game board.

The person who has selected X has the first turn. Players use their finger to trace an X or an O in their desired space. X is marked in blue, O in red.





**Begins** game

Alternating, player 1 will mark their X in one of the empty spaces. Then player 2 will mark an O in an available space.

The goal is to connect 3 of your marks together either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. In the example to the right, the X player has achieved Tic Tac Toe diagonally.



## How to Play (continued)

If neither player is able to connect 3 of their marks together, there is no winner and the game is a draw (example to the right). Neither player will receive a point in their score for that round.

Upon completing each round, the game will automatically begin the next round, whether or not there was a winning player.

The score is displayed along the edge of the screen and is updated after each round to reflect the player's win.



No winner

There is no limit to the amount of rounds you can play, so players should decide beforehand how many rounds will determine the winner.



Players can reset the score to 0 for both sides by touching the "Reset game" button along the edge.

Touching the menu button in the corner will launch the options screen, allowing you to quit the game or read the instructions.

## **Frequently asked questions**

#### What are the system requirements to run Tic Tac Toe'Touch?

Tic Tac Toe'Touch requires a multi-touch device, Dual Core Processor with 2 GB minimum memory, 4 GB recommended memory for optimal speed. Full HD resolution is also recommended for best performance.

#### What is the recommended age for Tic Tac Toe'Touch?

Tic Tac Toe'Touch is appropriate for children and adults of all ages.

#### Doesn't the player who selected X have an advantage as they mark the grid first?

Depending on the strategy, it may be advantageous to have the first move, giving the X player a greater chance. However, the starting player alternates each round, so once the first round is over, the O player will have the first selection, making the balance even.

#### What happens if there is no winner?

If neither player is successful in achieving 3 of their marks in a row, the game will flash on screen and automatically begin the next round. No points are awarded in the score box.

#### How many rounds determine a winner?

Tic Tac Toe'Touch allows you to play as many rounds as you like, so it is the players' decision how many rounds will determine the winner.

#### How do I quit Tic Tac Toe'Touch?

Touching the hand icon in the corner will load a menu with the option to quit or view instructions. If you only wish to reset the score but not exit, pushing the "Reset game" button on screen will end the current game and begin a new one.
